

Bassma Dawoud

We caught up with Bassma Dawoud, the rising actress you might recognize from heartwarming projects like *El Wasfa El Sehreya* and *Teta Zuzu*. She spilled behind-the-scenes stories from her new thriller *Ma Tarah Lays Kama Yabdou* with Tara Emad, and gave us a first look at her debut Saudi film *Esaaf*, where she shares the screen with Ibrahim El Hagag and Hassan Assiri. From passion and challenges to secrets and surprises, Bassma let us in on it all.

What is so different about the character of Noha in *Ma Tarah Lays Kama Yabdou* that made you want to play it?

Noha's character is different. It has many layers. Noha in the first episode is not like Noha in the second, third and soon. Noha's character requires a lot of studying and has details. There is addiction and a psychological issue. When I read all of this, it made me want to take part in this project and encourage me. Noha's character is special and has many layers, and as an actress I wouldn't ask for more.



Which scene in the *Ma Tarah Lays Kama Yabdou* did you enjoy filming the most? And why?

The kidnapping scene in the fifth episode. As much as this scene was psychologically and physically exhausting, I enjoyed it so much, because for this scene to come out great, it has to be very realistic. I have to look like I'm really kidnapped.

Tell us also about your movie, *Esaaf*, as an Arab film, Saudi Arabian-Egyptian. How was your experience working on that project?

The film, to me, was a completely different experience. I didn't film here in Egypt as usual, I filmed in Riyadh. Everything I'm used to was different there, the methods are different. Whenever anyone saw us filming in the outdoor sets like in the streets or shops, they would be very hospitable with us even though they didn't know us. I felt like despite being away from home, my family and my husband, I felt at home.



What cinematic or TV show line or catchphrase do you love the most?

I can tell you a statement that I had, in a really big size, on my wall in my room before I got married, it said "I Can." This statement is what made me achieve what I have now, and will continue to make me achieve better things because I can.

Which actor or actress do you want to work with?

I want to work with a lot of people. I want to work with Menna Shalaby, Karim Abdelaziz, Ahmed Ezz, Ahmed Mekky, Mona Zaki, many people. Even the people I have worked with, I'd like to work with them again because right now I'm different from me last year and the year before and so on. I feel that change with time, so of course the experience now would be different.

Which role do you think was the most challenging for you to play?

Nothing is difficult if you study it. To me, there is no difficult role, however all roles require work and studying. There are also some scenes that are harder than others. Roles that are unlike my real personality are easier for me than characters that are like me because I don't use my personality at all when playing a role.

What's a role you dream of playing in the future?

So many roles. I want to play all the roles out there. I want to work in drama, roles with psychological issues, various social states and social classes. I always welcome a good idea regardless of what I'll do.

You have worked in many genres so far, which genre do you feel you belong to the most?

I don't know, honestly. I worked on light comedy, drama and psycho drama. I was able to work on all of these and to me, I was happy with how it came out. I shouldn't limit myself to just one genre.

How do you balance between your work life and personal life?

No, I don't balance. There is no balance to them, you just try to do what you can here and there. When I have filming or a project, something like a war state happens at home where everything becomes systematic like the timings for meals and so on, and the same thing for my work. Also, Hany, my husband, helps me a lot actually.

Which actor would you like to collaborate with soon?



Which actor would you like to collaborate with in the future?


I have never worked with Meryl Streep, I would love to work with Meryl Streep.


Is there a difference between Jessica the content creator and Jessica the actress?

Long-time British resident Sohail Ali shares his love of the Al Rehab lifestyle, and why it feels like home.




Where do you live in Al Rehab, and when did you move here?


Best Golf Course Award for Egypt and Africa

On Staying Healthy

Professor Dr. Hany Ragy is a respected Consultant Cardiologist and Past Chairman of Cardiology National Heart Institute, Egypt. He updates us on steps to take us into a healthy new year.



Recent reports have shown that Egyptians in general have a low awareness level of heart health and wellness matters. How can this be addressed?

In Egypt there is a very low level of awareness in people with high blood pressure that they have it, and even those who are aware, have low levels of daily adherence to their blood pressure medications.

Is heart disease a significant problem in Egypt?


Unfortunately Egypt is among the highest countries for cardiovascular risk according to the European Society of Cardiology. This means that for someone living in Egypt when their 10 year cardiovascular risk is calculated based on their age, smoking history, history of diabetes and cholesterol analysis, they may actually require treatment earlier and in a more intensive way than someone with similar numbers living in say Sweden. There are factors like air pollution that the government must work on, but there are many personal individual measures that people, especially young ones can take to prevent future heart diseases.

What are the warning signs of a possible heart problem?

The cardiac symptoms that require seeking medical help are chest pain, fainting and being unusually short of breath with effort. Many healthy people have minor chest pains like stitching pain, or some palpitations that are usually benign.

What medical problems are on the rise in the Gen Z age group?

The new generation of young Egyptians has been targeted by the smoking industry by both old devices like water pipes and new ones like different forms of electronic smoking. The aim is to create young nicotine addicts who would have difficulty quitting later on. Smoking in all forms causes cancer and heart diseases. Presenting any form of smoking as harmless is a total lie; there is no harmless smoking and no safe level.



Obesity is also on the rise in Egypt, recent studies have shown high BMI, and prediabetes and fatty liver (MASLD) is on the rise in both adult and young Egyptians, regardless of economic and education status. **Again, this should be both addressed at its roots with healthy school meals for children, and of course by offering lifestyle advice regarding healthy food**, weight loss and exercise for all who are above their ideal body weight and BMI.



HOW CAN WE MANAGE THIS AND IMPROVE IT FOR FUTURE GENERATIONS?

Basically it is:

3 MEDICAL MEASURES:

Measuring and treating high blood pressure, high cholesterol and high blood sugar

5 LIFESTYLE MEASURES TO PROMOTE A HEALTHY HEART AND GOOD HEALTH:

Smoking cessation in any form, daily exercise (minimum 150 minutes of moderate aerobic exercise, like brisk walking weekly), adequate sleep of 8 hours daily, healthy food with enough fresh vegetables and fruits, and finally weight control.

How has treatment and medical technology for this advanced in recent years?

We are all learning how to use the wearables like smart watches with health and pulse apps, very useful if used properly. It is worth mentioning that there have been giant leaps in cardiovascular medicine in the last decade from percutaneous treatment of heart attacks and heart valve diseases to an amazing ability of cardiac imaging using CT and MRI and Ultrasound machines all available in Egypt.

How often are health checkups needed? What are the guidelines?

If people are young and healthy and have normal blood pressure and normal cholesterol, and no diabetes, they could get a yearly check or even longer like two or five yearly checks. Everyone should know their numbers regarding their blood pressure, blood sugar and blood cholesterol many medical websites provide free information, a useful one is the American College of Cardiology CardioSmart www.cardiosmart.org/topics/decisions/clinicians-start-a-conversation/posters

However if they suffer from any of those chronic conditions, or are under treatment they will be asked by their doctors for more frequent monitoring.




WHAT TO DO AND SEE


WHERE TO STAY

Inna, how long have you lived in Madinaty?


I have been living in Madinaty since 2011. Over the years, this place has become a space of comfort, growth, and inner peace for me.

Health Care: Medical professionals at all levels can effectively use AI to assist in their roles, but cannot be replaced by it.







Keeping Pets Cosy in Winter



General care




You cats or dog may like to snuggle up close. They enjoy your body warmth!




Your cat or dog should have a warm place to sleep, away from drafts. It is now much easier to find locally made pet beds, at affordable prices.




Pets do not need to be bathed as often. Excessive washing can deplete their coats of the natural oils that act to insulate them.



Some pets may want to eat more, in order to bulk up and preserve body temperature.



Cats and dogs should not be clipped in colder months, apart from a little grooming.



Check with your vet to make sure that all vaccinations are up to date. See if there are any supplements that can help your pet ward off winter chills as well.

Leashes and Collars: Dogs must be kept on a collar or leash when in public areas. Uncontrolled pets are a common cause for concern and subject to administrative action.




Waste Cleanup: Owners are required to clean up after their pets. The administration has provided free plastic bags in parks to facilitate this.



When using your car, it is recommended that you check around the vehicle or sound the horn before starting the engine. Cats sometimes seek warmth in the wheel wells or engine compartment of cars during lower temperatures and may be injured by a starting car.

The biggest fish I have ever caught was a Lout fish, and it weighed over 5 kilos. My dad helped me get it out!



DIFFERENT METHODS OF FISHING

Jigging is the method I always use while fishing in Ain Sokhna, but if you're a beginner, use a hook and bait. Jig fishing is like an injured baitfish that a game fish would want to bite. Reel fishing is best for older people, and when you need to cast the line a long distance.

STARTING OUT

If you are a little kid all you need is a mini-rod and a hook, and some small shrimp as bait. Put the bait on your hook, add a small weight to the line, and cast your line out. If you get a bite, pull your line in steadily so you don't lose your fish.

THE BEST TIME AND PLACE TO FISH

Pick a spot away from swimmers and other people of course. The best times are early morning, and around sunset. There are fishing apps that can tell you the best places and times.

Ask mom to help you make these festive treats to brighten your holiday season.


What you will need

1 cup unsalted butter, softened
1 cup superfine sugar
1 sachet vanilla
1 large egg
3 cups all-purpose flour
3/4 tsp baking powder
3/4 tsp salt

Icing Ingredients
3 egg whites
450g icing sugar
1 small sachet vanilla
Food colouring



Step 1




180°C



Preheat oven to 180°C. Line 2 baking sheets with parchment paper.

Step 2

Beat butter and sugar in a large bowl until creamy.




Step 3

Add egg and vanilla, beat until completely combined. Add flour, baking powder, and salt. Start mixing slowly, then beat until the flour is mixed in.




Step 4

Scrape dough out of bowl. Pat together then cut in half. Roll each half out to 0.5cm, sprinkling with flour under and over the dough so it doesn't stick.



Step 5


Use cookie cutters to press out shapes and transfer to prepared baking sheets. Bake for 10 minutes, until the surface is pale golden. Allow cookies to cool completely on trays.



Icing Your Cookies

Beat egg whites in a large mixing bowl until frothy, about 1 minute. Make sure the bowl you whip your whites in is super clean. With the mixer on low speed, slowly add in icing sugar and vanilla. Beat until stiff, shiny peaks form.

Divide icing among small bowls, and dye with food colouring. Transfer to piping bags and decorate cookies.


